City of Edmonton - Daniel Boric, a Full Member of CACPT, was born and raised in Hamilton, Ontario and graduated from Mohawk College's Urban & Regional Planning Technician program in 2010 and Ryerson University's Urban and Regional Planning Program, in 2012. His career started with IBI Group in the City of Kitchener and City of Hamilton. Daniel now resides in Edmonton, Alberta where he continues to practice as a Principal Planner with the City of Edmonton's Infill Liaison Team. Most recently, he had the privilege of working on the Evolving Infill project, which explored how the City could welcome more people and new homes into Edmonton's older neighbourhoods, with a particular focus on "missing middle" housing forms. The project resulted in the Administration's newest action plan, Infill Roadmap 2018, which contains 25 actions the City will undertake in the next two years to welcome more diverse infill development into the city.
